- 1. Entries must have a minimum of 8 frames and a maximum of 12.**
- 2. The comic strip must address Newton's 3 Laws of Motion, gravity and friction.**
- 3. All entries must be accompanied by a written explanation of how each of Newton's 3 Laws of Motion are demonstrated and the effects of gravity and friction in the scenario.**
- 4. Be creative. Comic strips are often colorful, whimsical and most of all funny.**
